 - i. VI-SPDAT for individuals is ready
 - ii. CoC's to provide list of Providers who will need to Complete or View VI-SPDAT
 - 1. Received from 4 CoCs
 - iii. CoC's to confirm that a training plan is in place to ensure all users (existing and new) will receive training before accessing the assessment. Available from Orgcode.org
 - iv. Wilder will provide "Step 1 access" to make the assessment available based on the list provided by the CoC the outlines each provider that needs access.
 - 1. Expected to be completed for the 4 CoCs who have provided a list w/in 2 weeks. The rest will be done as time allows.
 - v. LSA's will provide Step 2 access" to "turn it on" attach to a servicepoint provider
 - 1. Must confirm that users are trained
 - vi. Wilder will confirm needed access Admin sections for needed providers
 - 1. Complex agencies

 - b. If we want to pull HIC using HMIS:
 - i. HMIS providers must align with HIC
 - ii. Program Descriptor Elements need to be updated in Servicepoint
 - iii. Beds/units need to be correctly tracked
 - Previous methods have been inconsistent across providers/agencies/CoCs
 - iv. Recommend information be collected and maintained at local levels rather than State.
 - Use LSAs or Agency Administrators
 - What will it take to get AA installed. What is the capacity of CoCs/Agencies to do this? In what time frame?
 - Could train AA in alignment with online training launch
 - c. Use HMIS for all or some component types this year to test it out?
